

Jordan Township Meeting Minutes
January 27, 2025

Present: Sue Falco (Supervisor), Rebekah Meads (Treasurer) Amy Smith (Clerk), Kirk Falco (Trustee), Jessica Morris (Trustee)

Meeting called to order at 6pm, recited Pledge of Allegiance

Meeting minutes from December 16th meeting were reviewed, J Morris made motion to approve the minutes, K Falco seconded. Motion passed unanimously.

R Meads presented the Treasurers Report.

S Falco discussed having board approval before engaging any legal services in an effort to keep expenses down.

Monthly bills/expenses were reviewed. S Falco made motion to pay invoices, J Morris second. Motion passed unanimously.

Antrim Sheriff: Lasater presented Sheriff's report. Jordan Township had a total of 548 incidents in 2024. Antrim Sheriff's department is currently down 3 deputies and 3 prospects are in training to fulfill those open spots.

Ordinance Report: Sothard was not in attendance.

FEMA Maps completion to be finalized by April 2025

MTA Annual training for the clerks position was discussed for A Smith to attend a 3 day training convention in April. The cost is \$400 plus mileage expenses. R Meads made motion to approve, S Falco seconded. Motion carried unanimously.

Poverty Tax Exemption guidelines for the 2025 tax year were presented by S Falco. A resolution was prepared and passed by the board unanimously.

A Special Meeting to review the proposed fiscal year budget will be held at the February 24, 2025 monthly meeting.

S Falco has requested to purchase a computer for the Supervisor and Board of Review. A Smith made a motion of an \$800 budget to cover the cost of a new computer. J Morris seconded, motion carried unanimously.

S Falco is working on obtaining quotes from waste transfer facilities in preparation for Spring Clean up which is currently scheduled on May 17, 2025.

The next phase of paving is slotted for Old State Road this spring/summer 2025. The board has questioned the contract terms set by Antrim County Road Commission as to whether Old State Road will be made into a Class A road to facilitate the amount of traffic that uses said road. The board agreed to table payment to Antrim County Road Commission until February's meeting.

S Falco has requested to create a resolution to remove annual meetings from Jordan Township. Roll Call was taken: S Falco (Aye), K Falco (Aye), J Morris (Aye), R Meads (Nay), A Smith (Abstained)
